UK Transplant Case Study

UK Transplant is the organisation responsible for matching and allocating donated organs. It is a part of NHS Blood and Transplant (NHSBT), a Special Health Authority within the NHS, which manages UK Transplant, the National Blood Service and Bio Products Laboratory.



The organisation provides a UK-wide service from our base at Stoke Gifford, close to Bristol city centre.

NHS Blood and Transplant will shortly open a state-of-the-art £60 million blood centre at Filton. Once fully operational, the Filton blood centre will be the largest blood-processing centre in the world, processing up to 600,000 units every year.

We have four leading universities in Bristol and Bath within our catchment area and this has been a considerable help to us in recruiting the highly-skilled employees we need.

Coupled with easy access to the M32, M4 and M5 motorways and with good rail and air links from Bristol Parkway Railway Station and Bristol International Airport, Bristol is an ideal location from which to connect with the rest of the United Kingdom.
